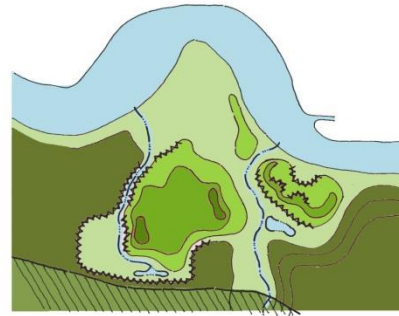

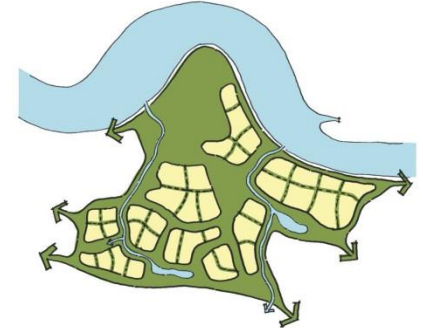

Landscape is the basis of the Ebbsfleet Implementation Framework ...

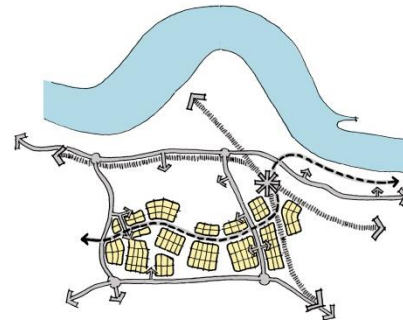
- Establishes 6 key spatial moves, to create the spatial DNA from which the places, culture and identity can continue to evolve.

- Not finished and needs to be cultivated, supported, curated and celebrated.



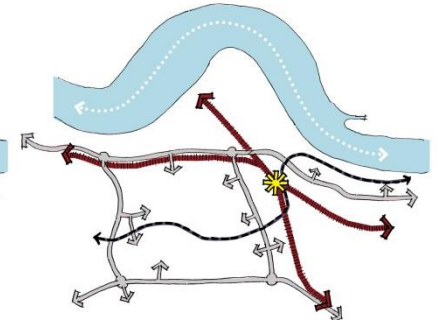
